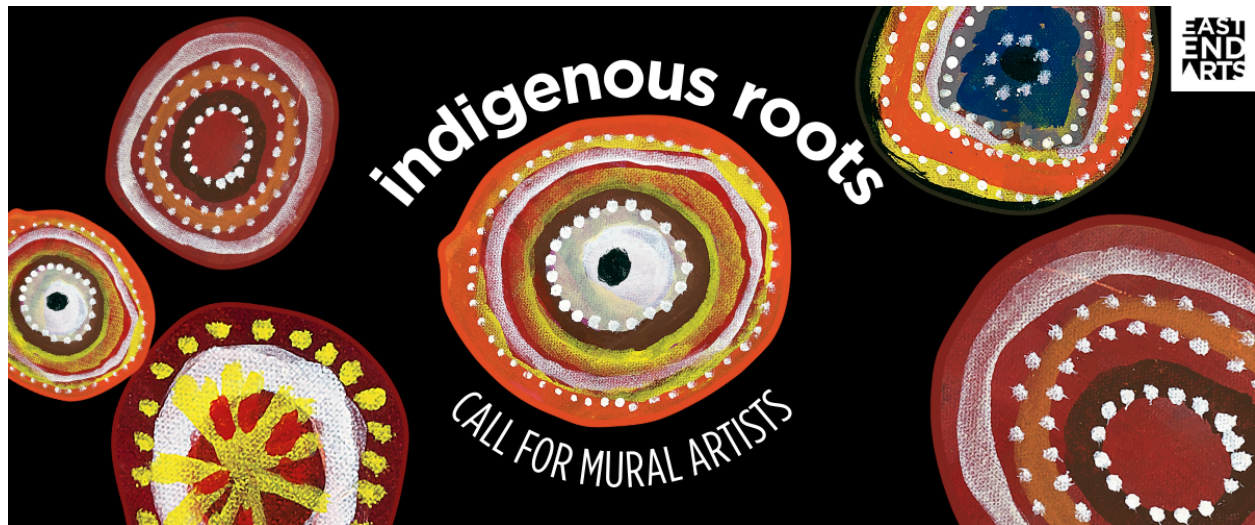


# Indigenous Roots: Call for Mural Artists - Info Sheet



**Location of Proposed Mural:** Indoor lobby space of the Eastminster Campus of East End United Regional Ministry (EEURM), 310 Danforth Avenue, Toronto, ON, M4K 1N6.

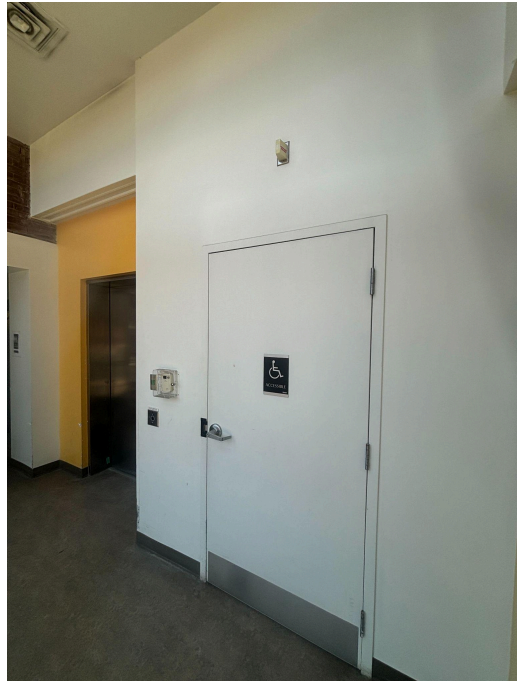
**Wall Size:** Approximately 300 sq ft of indoor wall space. Walls are approx 13 feet high, and vary in width. See photos below.

## Production Details:

- The selected artist or collective will be paid \$6,500 to paint approximately 300 sq ft of indoor wall coverage.
- Selected artists are in charge of sourcing and purchasing their own paint, supplies, and materials.
- Colour schemes will be completely up to artist discretion based on the designs submitted.
- Potential ladders and/or scaffolding will be provided (at no extra cost to the artist(s)), but selected artists/collectives are expected to have up-to-date Working At Heights Training.
- Storage within the EEURM will be provided for the selected artist(s).
- Suggested mural themes include: Indigenous Representation, Brilliance, Joy, Interconnectedness, Land Stewardship, Cultural Preservation, and other themes as chosen by the artists who apply.
- If requested, an Elder will be available throughout the lifecycle of this mural project to be a support person for Indigenous artists.

## **Measurements and Notes:**

Wall one features an elevator and the door to an accessible washroom. The approximate size of this wall is 4 meters (13 ft) high, and 4 meters (13 ft) wide. The door to the accessible washroom will be painted on, but the doors to the elevator are to remain untouched (along with the buttons and thermostats that are on the wall). The accessible washroom sign and door handle must also not be altered. This wall is viewable from the sidewalk and outside ramp (as seen in the last photo).

Wall two is a blank canvas (to the right of the washroom door). The approximate size of this wall is 4 meters (13 ft) high, and 2 meters (6.5ft) wide. Both the pale yellow section of the wall and the white areas above will be painted.

Wall three is to the left of the elevator. There is not a lot of wall space here, as it mainly includes a bit of an archway that connects the main entrance area to the elevator lobby area. The exit sign above the arch is not to be altered, but it would be nice to have this wall feel included in the rest of the design.

The ceiling will remain white and untouched.
